Tour Balance Payment Due!

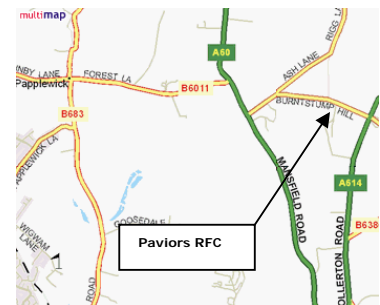

Directions to Pavions RFC

On Sunday we are heading into Robin Hood country to play Pavions & Hinckley. It is about an hour away so please allow plenty of time to get there.

Take the M1 to J26 then the A610 towards Nottingham (then Nottingham & Arnold) after about 3 miles turn left onto the A6514 Western Boulevard Ring Road towards Mansfield, After 2 ½ miles turn left at the Vale PH onto the A60 still towards Mansfield. After a few miles turn right onto Burntstump Hill signposted Police HQ & Park Hospital. Follow this road to the brow of hill then turn right into School Lane where there is a sign to Cockcliffe House hotel. Follow this to the right being careful of sleeping policemen and potholes. When you see the ground keep it on the left and it will lead you straight to the car park and clubhouse.
